Ms. Judy Wilson and Jill Albaugh

Judy Wilson is the Director of the Procurement and Contracts Division, U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Oak Ridge Office. She is responsible for overseeing, administering, and support of over \$3 billion in procurement and financial assistance awards and \$2 billion in Federal and contractor personal property at the Oak Ridge DOE and other offices across the Department's complex. She also manages real estate activities on the Oak Ridge Reservation and oversees the Oak Ridge Office Small Business program. Judy has over 30 years of government service. In 2004, she was promoted to Branch Chief of the Environmental Acquisitions Branch and has served as Director since 2006. A native Oak Ridger, Wilson earned a Bachelors Degree in Business Administration from the University of Tennessee and a Masters in Business Administration from Bristol University. Judy, her husband, and sons live in Oak Ridge.

Jill Albaugh serves as the Contracting Officer for the U. S. Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Y-12 Site Office (YSO).
