SPEAKER

JOHN SACKS

Mr. Sack has been employed as a senior financial analyst since January of 2009. He has provided consulting services for several DOD and DOE contractors. He has also participated in a variety of strategic initiative reviews including the (1) the development of model to identify the cost of idle facilities (2) input in the proper accounting and savings related to a special Army funding initiative and (3) computation of the current and future cost impact from transitioning an Army activity from government owned to a commercial venture.

Mr. Sack retired from the Defense Contract Audit Agency with forty two and a half years of service. He was the Nashville Branch Manager responsible for 30 - 35 professional auditors. He received more than 26 performance awards for sustained superior accomplishments.

Mr. Sack was part of the Nashville branch for 25 years from 1984 to 2009. This audit position included responsibility for over one hundred government contractors located throughout Tennessee and Kentucky. Mr. Sack's DCAA experience also includes five years as the resident auditor at the Radford Army Ammunition Plant and twelve and a half years in various offices in the Northern New Jersey Area. These audit positions included responsibility over several hundred contractors located in Northern New Jersey, Southwest Virginia and North Carolina.

At different times in his DCAA career, Mr. Sack has had audit responsibility for the Radford, Milan, Iowa and Holston Army Ammunition Plants and an Air Force GOCO at the Arnold Engineering Development Center. Mr. Sack's wealth of GOCO experience resulted in his assignment as a core member of the Idle Facilities Audit (IFA) team. This team reviewed the status of activity at the Milan, Iowa, Lake City, Holston, Scranton and Radford GOCOs. The final

IFA report has been very well received at the highest levels of the Army. It continues to be used to evaluate major budget decisions regarding the government's investment in the GOCO complex.

Mr. Sack's audit experience required him to review and develop audit opinions on a wide range of government contractor accounting, budget, production scheduling and control and estimating systems. He has

also participated in review of many multi-million dollar proposals, equitable adjustment claims and extraordinary relief claims.

Mr. Sack was a Certified Public Accountant for many years. He elected to be classified as an inactive CPA coincident with his retirement from DCAA. Mr. Sack holds a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Seton Hall University.
